

## About Truth

Usually the term "truth" is referred to as matching with commonly accepted reality.

Absolute truth, however, is eternal and unchangeable.

The Bible says:

*" Yes, my Lord and God, you're the only God, and Your words are true. "* (2 Sam 7, 28 . )

This truth, being a divine value, will lead man to a life to wisdom and discernment, a path that will lead him into unity with the Father.

*"Love of the truth also means rejection of injustice and wickedness. "*  
( 2 Thessalonians 2, 10ff )

Jesus says of himself that he is the truth and one with the Father.

*"I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. "* ( John 14: 6 ) *" I and the Father are one. "* ( John 10: 30)

A spiritual man will acknowledge the truth in God.

*"And God said to Moses : "I am who I am." ( 2 Genesis 3,14)*

In contrast to the unchanging truth, physical creation is in a constant state of flux. Through the cycle of birth and death, that which appears to be reality today, will be recognized to be an illusion tomorrow .

The secular man, due to his deluded way of thinking, believes himself to be an independent natural being. This egocentric conviction arises through identification with the physical body. However, if he realizes that he really is a part of a bigger body, egocentric attachment will vanish.

Man will wake up to be in the One, that is composed of many members .

*"For as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body : so it is with Christ ".* ( 1 Cor 12, 12 )

The illusion of separation from God will vanish when the man of God will recognize reality, expressing his presence through love for all creatures.

Overcoming the worldly deception with truth is the way to Jesus. Through Him we experience the unity in the Father.

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
